

Choosing a career is like any other activity; it is best to work to a plan. Too many people start looking for a specific job before thinking out their occupational aims. It is a good idea to begin by attempting to define in clear terms what your requirements are from a career. This involves taking a realistic view of your strengths and weaknesses. You may think for example, that you would like a job, which involves organizing people, but liking such a job is not a sufficient justification if experience you already may have suggests that this is not your strong point. On the other hand, you should remember that training will equip you to do new things. A further point to consider is how far you will be willing to do for a time things which you do not like knowing that they are necessary to achieve your longer term objectives. Having thought carefully about the sort of person you are, try to work out a realistic set of occupational requirements. In particular, you can answer to important questions.

First: what determines the choice of profession? Is it easy to choose a profession you like? Why IT career is very popular nowadays? What personal traits and skills are needed for any job? What's the best job for you? Why? Is leisure time of great importance to you? Is the size of your salary important? Do you want to settled or travel widely?

Second: what sort of work do you want to do? For example, do you like working alone or in a team? Do you want to be an organizer of other people's activities? Do you want to develop new ideas and initiate changes?
